We have two more weeks of state testing coming up. We have the tenth grade state assessment, called the Math Smarter Balance Assessment (SBA) test on May 21st and 22nd.

On May 30th all eleventh grade students will take the science assessment. That test is for federal accountability.

The ninth grade students should arrive at normal time for all testing days. They will be completing worthwhile and educational activities including **working on their High School and Beyond Plan**.

Juniors and seniors *not* testing will follow a late start schedule and should arrive at school at the end of the testing period if they are not testing. Due to the testing throughout the campus, juniors and seniors arriving early will be joining the freshman activities.
