Board Policy 3112 states, “Students age 16 or older identified by themselves or staff as potential dropouts shall become a focus of attention (of the district).” And, “Reasonable efforts shall be made to persuade the student to remain in school and complete the requirements for a diploma. If unsuccessful at that, staff shall attempt to find placement in an appropriate alternative educational setting.” And, “The superintendent shall submit an annual early withdrawal report to the board, which outlines the age and grade level for each student, the reason(s) for leaving, and any follow-up data that has been collected after the student has withdrawn.”

As of February 9, 2022, the following data reflects all students known to fall under the early withdrawal description are:
